Bring: Your registration form, blank or toned canvas, and registration fee. REGISTRATION CLOSES PROMPTLY at 8:30am.

Paint

When: 9-11am

Where: Within the designated painting area on the map.

What: Works should be no smaller than 8" either vertically or horizontally.

Canvases may be toned.

Sketches created in a sketchbook prior to the morning of the event ARE allowed.

NO sketching on your canvas or panel prior to 9am.

Reference photographs may NOT be used.

Get Stamped

What: Canvases must have two stamps to be considered for awards - one at registration and another upon completion.

When: Noon-3pm

Bring: Your painting and your own easel to set up work at PenArt (works must be for sale).

Celebrate

When: 6-8pm

Win & Sell

PenArt will retain 40% of the sale price listed.

Artist's and People's Choice awards announced at 7:40 pm.

Dockside Quick Paint works may only be sold through the PeArt. No "off the easel" sales allowed. Individuals who have participated as a featured artist in the Door County Plein Air Festival in prior years may participate in the Quick Paint, however, they are NOT eligible for the First Place Award.

Pick Up Work

Unsold works must be picked up by 8pm on July 29^h.
